Undergrad: Internal

CS Academic Achievement Medal

- **Eligibility:** **graduating** student enrolled in **Honors CS** or other FPAS program
- **Value:** \$ n*100.00
- **No. of Awards:** varies (last year: 4)
- **Requirements:** academic achievements and contribution to the life of the department / university
- **Deadline:** -

Undergrad: Internal

CGI Award

- **Eligibility:** students majoring in **CS or IT**
- **Value:** \$ 1000.00
- **No. of Awards:** 3
- **Requirements:**
 - 1) minimum GPA – 6.0 (B)
 - 2) Canadian citizen / permanent resident
 - 3) demonstrated financial need
- **Deadline:** October 12, 2005

Undergrad: Internal

Allen S. Berg Awards

- **Eligibility:**
 - 1) outstanding 3rd of 4th year CS student
 - 2) graduating CS student
- **Value:** \$ 250.00
- **No. of Awards:** 1 - each
- **Requirements:** students are selected based on academic merit
- **Deadline:** October 12, 2004

Undergrad: Internal

Charma Mordido Bursary

- **Eligibility:** female CS students
- **Value:** \$ 600.00
- **No. of Awards:** 1
- **Requirements:**
 - 1) Canadian citizen / permanent resident
 - 2) demonstrated financial need
- **Deadline:** October 12, 2004

Undergrad: Internal

General Motors Bursary

- **Eligibility:** students majoring in **CS**
- **Value:** \$ 2500.00
- **No. of Awards:** 3
- **Requirements:**
 - 1) Canadian citizens / permanent residents
 - 2) demonstrated financial need
- **Deadline:** October 12, 2004

Undergrad: External

NRC Women in Engineering and Science Award

- **Eligibility:** **2nd year female student** in engineering, science or mathematics
- **Value:** \$ 10,000.00 to 12,000.00 per year
(4 months summer co-op required / provided)
- **No. of Awards:** 19 overall
- **Requirements:**
 - 1) Canadian citizen / permanent resident
 - 2) academic achievement
 - 3) demonstrate ability and willingness to be role model in encouraging other women to pursue careers in engineering and science
- **Deadline:** October 15, 2004

Undergrad: External

NSERC Undergraduate Award in Universities

- **Eligibility:** registered undergrad student in natural science or engineering program
- **Value:** \$ 4,500.00 + university contribution
- **No. of Awards:** **York, 2003: 57**
- **Requirements:**
 - 1) Canadian citizen / permanent resident
 - 2) full-time, completed 30-credits
 - 3) 6.0 (B) or higher average
 - 4) supervised by NSERC-awarded faculty
 - 5) engaged in research during tenure of award (**16-week program**)
- **Deadline:** January, 2005

Undergrad: External

NSERC Undergraduate Award in Industry

- **Eligibility:** registered undergrad student in natural science or engineering program
- **Value:** \$ 4,500.00 (25% supplemented by host company)
- **No. of Awards:** **York, 2003: 3**
- **Requirements:**
 - 1) Canadian citizen / permanent resident
 - 2) full-time, completed 30-credits
 - 3) 6.0 (B) or higher average
 - 4) be engaged in R&D activities in host company
(12-16 weeks program)
- **Deadline:** 3 weeks prior to scheduled start date

Undergrad: External

CRA-W Canadian Distributed Mentor Project

- **Eligibility:** **female** CS or CE undergraduate student and female professor
- **Value:** student: up to \$ 5,000.00 as supplement to NSERC undergraduate award
professor: \$ 1,000.00 to offset research
- **No. of Awards:** **Canada, Summer 2004: 4**
- **Requirements:** NSERC undergrad. award requirements
- **Deadline:** February, 2005

Undergrad: External

Millennium Excellence Award

- **Eligibility:** full-time enrolment in a degree program
- **Value:** local/provincial: \$ 4,000 annually
national: \$ 5,000 annually
- **No. of Awards:** York, currently: 25
- **Requirements:**
 - 1) Canadian citizen / permanent resident
 - 2) cumulative post-sec. GPA of 7.0 (B+)
 - 3) exhibited leadership, innovation, etc.
 - 4) **have NOT be previously awarded a substantial merit scholarship for post-sec. education**
- **Deadline:** June, 2005

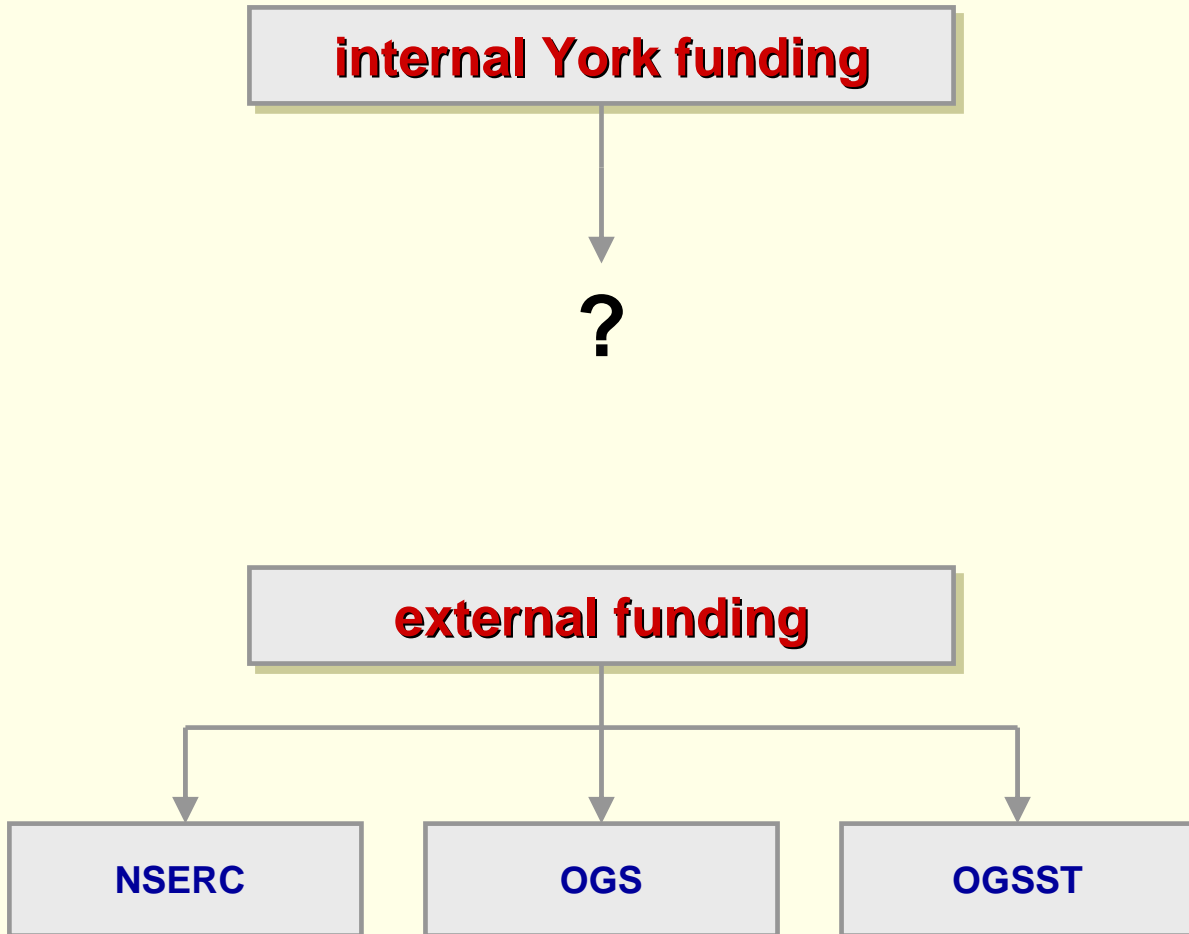

Graduate: External

N SERC

- **Eligibility:** full-time M.Sc. and Ph.D. students in natural science and engineering
- **Value:** M.Sc. Level (PGS-A): \$ 17,300 annually
Ph.D. level (PGS-B): \$ 21,000 annually
- **No. of Awards:** York, 2004: 22
- **Requirements:**
 - 1) Canadian citizen / permanent resident
 - 2) maintained GPA of at least A-
 - 3) cannot be held with OGS and OGSST
- **Deadline:** October, 2004

Graduate: External

OGS by Ontario Ministry of Education and Training

- **Eligibility:** full-time M.Sc. or Ph.D. student in variety of disciplines
- **Value:** \$ 15,000 annually
- **No. of Awards:**
- **Requirements:**
 - 1) Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or **international student**
 - 2) average of at least A-
 - 3) cannot be held with OGSST or NSERC
- **Deadline:** October, 2004

Graduate: External

OGS in Science and Technology by Ontario Ministry of Education and Training

- **Eligibility:** full- or **part-time** M.Sc. and Ph.D. students science and technology program
- **Value:** \$ 15,000 annually
(2/3 by Ministry, 1/3 by University)
- **No. of Awards:**
- **Requirements:**
 - 1) Canadian citizen / permanent resident
 - 2) average of at least A-
 - 3) cannot be held with NSERC and OGS
- **Deadline:** conditional on availability of funds
