Select a topic from the course "The Universe at Radio Wavelengths" and get approval from Prof. Bartel. When approved, write a single-spaced report by using as font "Times New Roman." Start with a title, your name and an Abstract, about 5 to 10 lines long, which summarizes your report. Use size 10 for the Abstract and size 12 thereafter. The main part of your report should contain an Introduction, a Science section and an approximately half-page Summary or Conclusions section at the end. You can also choose to have subsections in the Science section to give your report more structure if you think that that is useful for the reader. Include figures, tables and equations if needed. The figures should have numbers (e.g. Figure 1, Figure 2...), figure captions about one to two sentences long, and the figures should be referred to in the body of the report. The same goes for Tables. Give references at the end of your report in a References section and make sure that you refer to the references in the body of your report. The total length of your document including references should be 10 pages.
