Call for Travel Scholarship Applications



The York University Department of Physics & Astronomy is pleased to announce three travel scholarships to attend the 2016 Canadian Association of Physicists (CAP) conference at the University of Ottawa during June 13-17, 2016 (http://www.cap.ca/en/congress/2016). This is an excellent opportunity to get exposed to a broad range of physics and biophysics research topics "outside the classroom". Each scholarship will be for \$400 to defray costs associated with attending (i.e., bus/train travel, shared hotel, registration via CAP membership, and a daily food allowance).

<u>Who</u> —> All York undergraduate PHYS and BPHS majors are eligible to apply, including those who will graduate in 2016.

What —> Interested students should prepare a 1 page proposal that includes:

- name, major, and year entered
- description of why you want to attend and what you hope to gain
- current GPA (along with a brief description justifying any weaknesses in this regard; a low GPA will not necessarily preclude you from consideration, so don't be discouraged from applying)
- brief description for budget justification (i.e., outline how you'll use \$400 to attend the event)
- one name of a reference (e.g., professor you have worked with or know well from a course)
