VENUE LOCATIONS & PARKING

York University activities: May 9, 10 and the morning of the 11th

Venue: Junior Common Room of McLaughlin College, Room 014 McLaughlin College on York University campus at 4700 Keele Street, Toronto

Parking: Founders Road, lots 3A and 3B (\$7.50 flat daily rate). Turn South off Steeles, between Jane and Keele.

TTC: from Downsview station, bus 106 or 196 to York University. Final stop is in front of York Lanes. McLaughlin College is in the building complex immediately to the North.

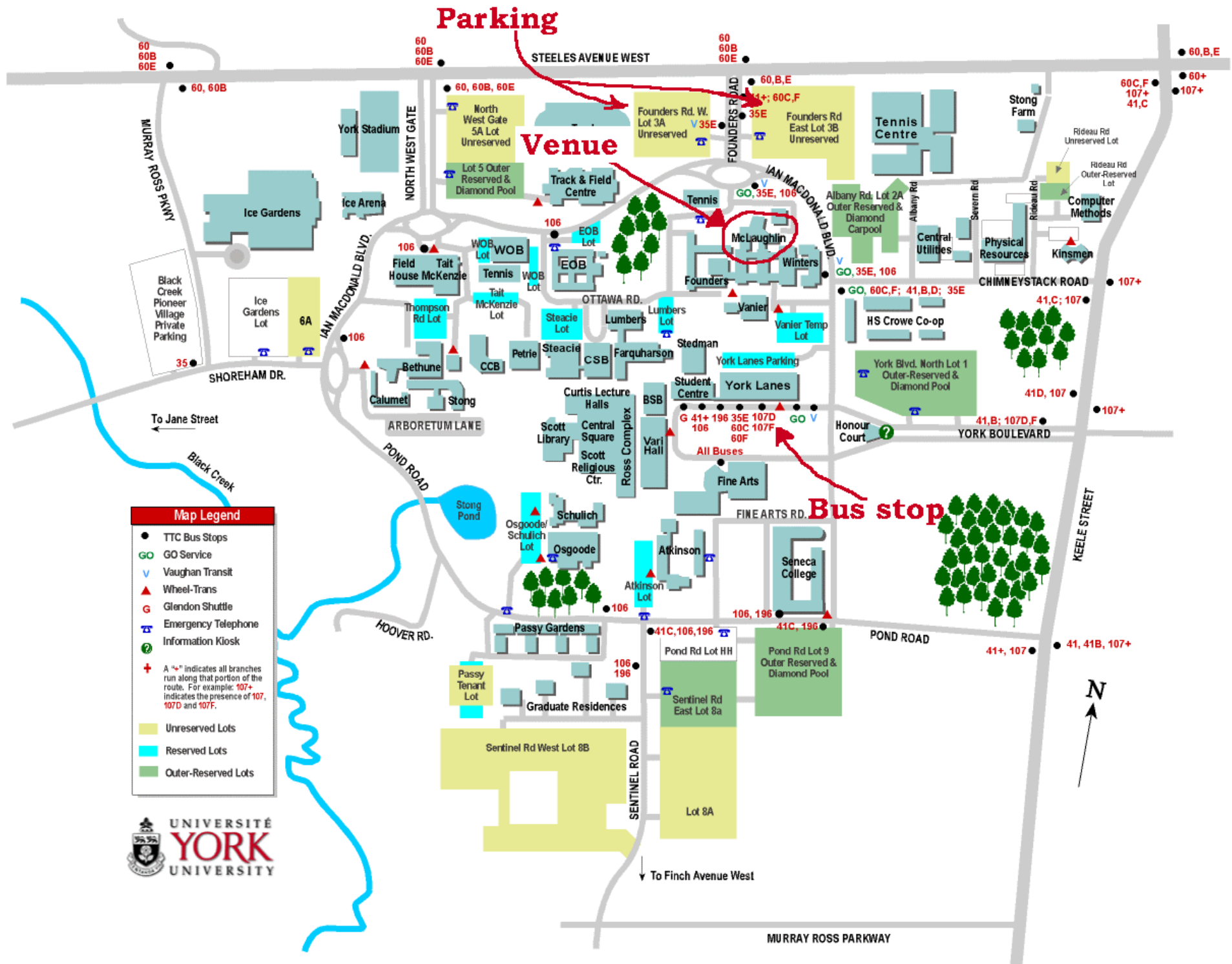

Downtown activity, evening of May 11th:

Venue: Koffler Institute of Pharmacy Management, OISE, University of Toronto Room 108, 569 Spadina Avenue (between Spadina and Harbord)

Parking: 1 Spadina Crescent - in the middle of the traffic circle on Spadina between College and Harbord Streets. Enter from the north end. For non-University lots, there is a lot under the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (the former Clarke Institute) just north of College Street on the east side of Spadina; there is limited street parking on Spadina; and a public lot just west of Spadina on the south side of College.

TTC: Spadina subway station and either walk south on Spadina (which is about a five minute walk) or take the Spadina LRT south and get off at Willcocks Street which is the first street south of Harbord. Alternatively, it is a short walk north from College on Spadina.
