



York University-MITACS Vision Science Summer School

June 3-8, 2012

The Centre for Vision Research at York University in Toronto offers a one-week, all-expenses-paid undergraduate summer school on vision science.



The program includes talks by Centre for Vision Research (CVR) faculty members on current research in vision science, as well as hands-on projects in CVR laboratories. The curriculum reflects the wide range of research areas at CVR, which includes basic research on vision in humans and animals, covering both neuroscience and behaviour, as well as applied topics such as computer vision, virtual reality, visual perception in low-gravity environments, and vision in clinical populations.



The program will accept 24 undergraduate students who are interested in pursuing a career in scientific research.

The program provides on-campus accommodations, breakfast and lunch each day, a closing banquet, and also covers transportation costs.
