- -Final data column includes only Tenure Stream Faculty

#### Notes from OIRA re. calculations:

- -Faculty FTEs = OSFTEs for Full-Time Faculty plus FTEs for Contract Faculty
- -Full-Time Faculty FTEs = Faculty FTEs for all Full-Time Faculty including Probationary, Tenured, CLAs and SRCs
- -Tenure Stream Faculty FTEs = Faculty FTEs for Probationary and Tenured Full-Time Faculty only
