

GLOSSARY

FFTE (Fiscal Full-Time Equivalent)

For Undergraduate students, a Fiscal Full-Time Equivalent or "full-time equivalent student for funding purposes" equates to a student course load of 30 credits over 2 terms. For full-time Graduate students, 1 FFTE equates to a one-term load. For part-time Graduate students, 0.3 FFTE equates to a one-term load.

Funded FFTE

Not all active students are funded by MET. Undergraduate students who are not funded include:

- i) first year students who have entered York directly from an Ontario high school without 6 OAC's;
- ii) students studying in programmes which have not received Ministry funding approval;
- iii) students studying at York under the terms of an Exchange Program.

Graduate students who are not funded include:

- i) students who have been in a programme for too long;
(i.e., the student has accumulated more than a maximum number of BIU's set down by the Ministry);
- ii) students in programmes which have not received Ministry funding approval.

NOTE: In 1989 the name of the graduate program in Physical Education was changed to Exercise and Sports Science.

In 1997 the name of the graduate program in Physical Education was changed to Kinesiology & Health Science.
