STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE:

RESIDENCE REQUIREMENT: At least 30 credits must be taken at York and at least half of the Psychology requirements must be satisfied by PSYC courses offered by the Psychology Departments at York (Arts, Atkinson, Glendon).

GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS: Twelve credits from at least two different subjects of study outside the Faculty of Science & Engineering must be completed (see details on reverse).

UPPER LEVEL REQUIREMENT: Students must meet the upper-level requirement, which is 18 credits at the 3000 level or 4000 level. At least 12 credits in Psychology must be at the 3000 or 4000 level.

SCIENCE REQUIREMENT: At least 66 credits must be from Science (sc) credits.
