Reporting to the Project Manager Clinical Informatics, the Clinical Informatics Specialist (CIS) provides leadership and support for ehealth initiatives across the organization, serving as a role model and mentor who champions the use of technology in clinical practice. In collaboration with the Project Manager, the CIS coordinates and participates in aspects of systems analysis, planning, design, development, testing, education and implementation of information systems and clinical decision support tools. The CIS manages relationships across diverse stakeholder groups, serving as a liaison between frontline users, management, IT professionals, and Finance. The CIS is responsible for liaising with vendors, and providing user/administrative support for a variety of applications including Meditech, HInext TREAT, and Philips OB TraceVue. The Clinical Informatics Specialist leads and coordinates workload measurement reporting for nursing and allied health professionals. The CIS participates in planning and related efforts to advance the electronic health record within the organization and across the CE LHIN.
