The Department of Communication Studies invites applications from qualified candidates for two (2) one-year Sessional Assistant Professor positions in Communication Studies. Applicants must have a completed PhD and an active research program in a relevant discipline. Applicants should be prepared to teach a full year's load of three courses drawn from one or more of the following three areas: 1) Politics and Policy, 2) Media, Culture and Society, and 3) Communication Theory and Methods. Candidates must be able to teach effectively in large-lecture formats.

These positions carry a teaching load of three full courses or the equivalent. The start date is July 1, 2012. All York University positions are subject to budgetary approval.

The deadline for applications is March 23, 2012.
