These decisions were made by Foundations faculty.

*Calendar description will include reference to the Foundations program and will identify the critical skills the course will address. This material should also be included in the course outline. (Decision made Sept 2002.)

*All Foundations course outlines should include relevant information from the "Course Outline Template" mounted on the Foundations website in order to enhance student access to information. (Decision made Sept 2003.)

* The *Academic Honesty* handout from the Faculty of Arts should be attached to all Foundations course outlines. Course secretaries can arrange to have this sheet attached when the course outline is reproduced. (Decision made Sept 2002.)

*First year courses will assign the two on-line tutorials as part of required work (or substitute alternative format). (Decision made Sept 2003 to begin in AY 2004-5.)

*Foundations courses will use a 150 grade point base to support the 9 credit workload. (Decision made in Dec 2003 to pilot this approach in AY 2004-5).
