After 10 years split between the private sector and academia, Dr. Adalsteinn (Steini) D. Brown was appointed in March 2006 as the Assistant Deputy Minister, responsible for strategy at the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC).

He is also an Assistant Professor in Health Policy, Management and Evaluation at the University of Toronto. He has served as an advisor to hospital networks, banks and governments in North America, Europe and Asia, as well as to the World Health Organization on health system strategy and hospital reform.

He received his D.Phil from the University of Oxford where he was a Rhodes Scholar.

He was named one of Canada's Top 40 Under 40 in 2003.
