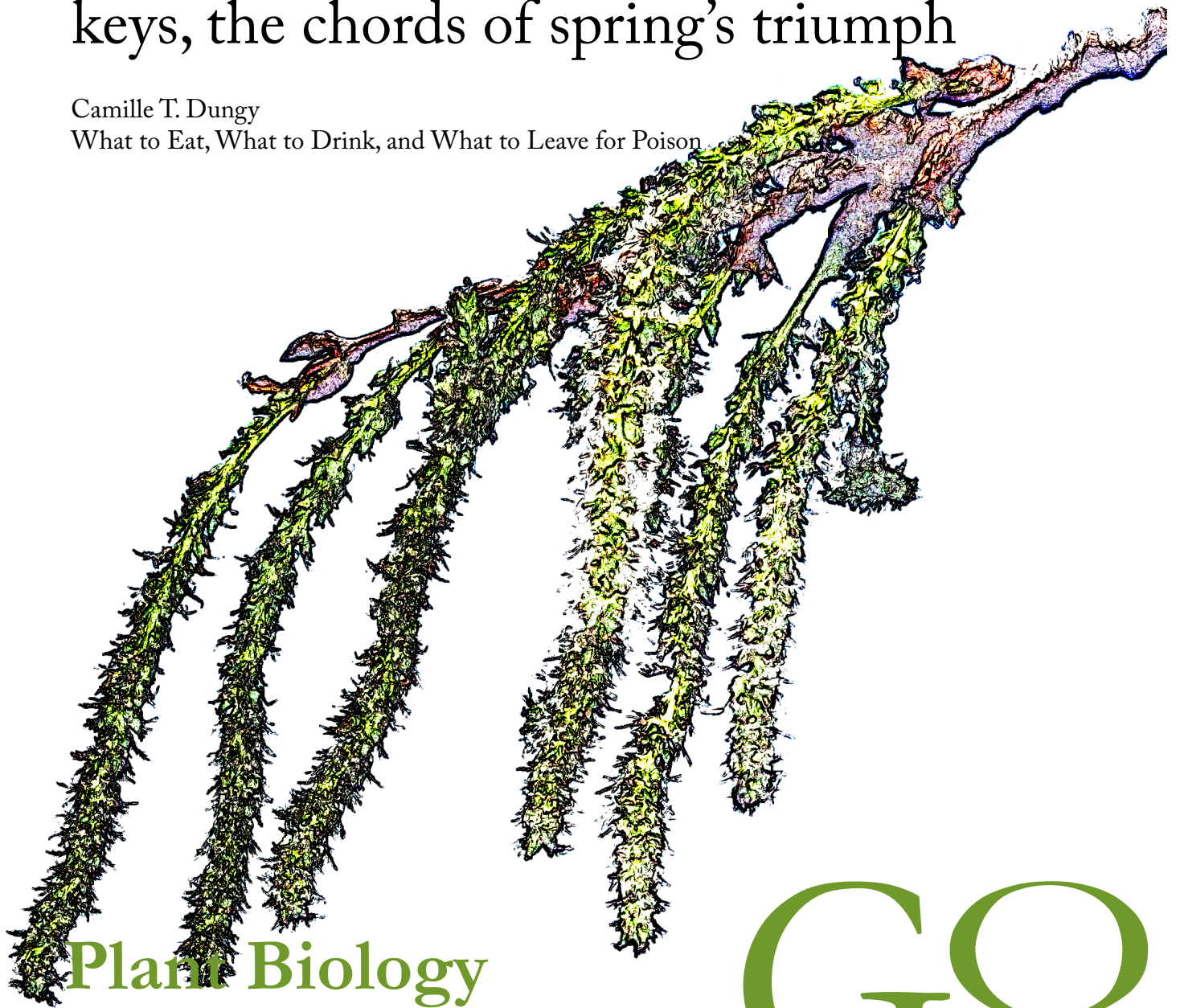


But now, in spring, the buds
