To be eligible, candidates:

- must be over the age of 19
- must be full-time students, currently enrolled in or graduating from a journalism or film program
- must demonstrate strong writing ability and a passion for cinema and the arts
- must be available to cover the full 10 days of the Festival, including evenings and weekends

Preference will be given to applicants who are available for some pre-Festival events and activities in July and August.

To apply:

- Submit either one review of a Canadian film, or one article on the Canadian film industry (500 words maximum). The review or article does not need to have been published.
- Submit 2-3 additional writing samples (maximum 500 words each), preferably written in journalistic style. These samples do not need to have been published.
- Submit your résumé.
