SECURITY AWARENESS TIPS

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Three robberies on campus have been reported to York Security in the last two months. The Toronto Police Service is investigating these incidents. To enhance your personal safety and prevent you from becoming a victim, members of the York community are reminded to:

- Be alert to your surroundings. Trust your instincts and notice who is nearby and what is happening in the area around you.
- If possible travel with a partner – there is safety in numbers.
- Be aware that wearing headphones and using a cellular phone can be a distraction and may reduce your awareness of what is occurring around you.
- Do not display valuable items such as jewelry and cash while limiting the amount of cash you carry on your person.
- Make use of the Student Security Escort Service which can be reached by using the Blue Light Emergency Telephones, by calling 416-736-5454 (or ext 55454). The call is free from all campus payphones. At Glendon Campus, please call 416-487-6799 (or ext 66799)
- When confronted give the culprit only what is demanded as quickly as possible...do not argue and avoid becoming involved in a physical confrontation.
- Try to remember as much detail about the suspect's physical description.
