| Strategic Research Plan (R. Haché) (presented overview slides) | <p>VPRI Rob Haché welcomed Faculty members and presented a series of slides outlining the need for a new SRP, content and upcoming consultation process. Highlighted the need for an Institutional SRP built on Unit and Faculty plans, informing the UAP – needing a strong, broadly supported vision to help us increase our participation in research and the recognition we receive for our research. Underscored the need for Faculty feedback as integral to the development of the Strategic Research Plan- very important to ensure that the University-wide Strategic Research Plan echoes the research programs and core research values identified by each of the Faculties, as reflected by existing or emerging Faculty strategic plans. Concluded presentation by asking faculty members how we might seek to identify and incorporate the strategic directions of Glendon College within the SRP.</p> <p><u>Comments & Clarifications from Glendon College Faculty Council:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Ensure that the plan addresses ways to better enable research at York, in particular empowering ORUs by enhancing support, creating a balance between teaching and research, and addressing administrative red tape ie: expense reimbursement policy -Ensuring the plan addresses research ethics and the protocols around conducting research at York -Inclusiveness – plan should incorporate undergrad students -Two key strategic directions of Glendon College have been identified within the Glendon Academic Plan and should be taken into consideration <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Study of Language and Culture - Study of Canadian and International Affairs -Stressed need for SRP to recognize the bilingual duality as academic tradition |
