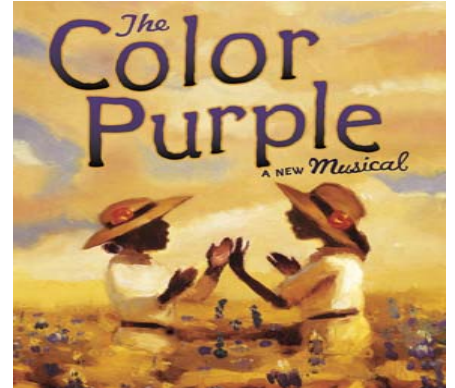

- Contestants must be a current undergraduate York student and complete a registration form in person by **Friday, February 4, 2011**.
- Submit manuscript in duplicate to 315 Stong College by **Friday, February 25, 2011 at 4 pm**. Please include your personal statement explaining which item(s) from the archives inspired your work.

The winning submission will receive **\$750**, with **\$250** going to the runner-up. Winners announced at a reception, date and venue to be determined later.
