

Selection/Placement 2012-13

Eligibility:

As a current student, you will be eligible for residence if you meet the following criteria:

1. You have a decision from the university that you are eligible to proceed, AND
 2. You enroll as a full-time student for the 2012-13 academic session in an undergraduate program (18 credits over F/W terms or 9 credits per term), AND
 3. You have no significant behavioral infractions reported while previously occupying the York residences, AND
 4. You have no outstanding debt on your student account from previous academic terms.
- Residence and Room Assignment

Students who apply back to their current residence will have priority over students who request to transfer from a different residence, in most cases.

Semi- Private rooms are very limited and requests always exceed the space available. Students who apply for Hilliard G House and currently live on a traditional Floor in the residence should expect to be on a waitlist without any guarantee.

You can also select a room, floor, or suite preference on your application however specific assignments cannot be guaranteed.

Upper year students can also apply to share a double room if they are of the same gender.

If you did not live in residence previously then your preferences cannot be guaranteed and room offers will be made according to availability of any space in any residence building. Housing will make every effort to accommodate your preferences, but we reserve the right to assign all residence space according to availability, suitability, fairness and need.

NOTE: Smoking is not permitted anywhere in any residence building.

Offer Acceptance and Confirmation

Your residence assignment and offer package will be sent to you by e-mail. To accept your residence offer, you must reply by the deadline specified in your offer letter:

1. Return your acceptance letter, meal plan selection, and residence contracts.
2. Pay a \$300 non-refundable room deposit to your Student Account when you will accept a room offer.

Information about moving in and other residence services will be included with your offer package.

Students will be offered a specific room in a specific residence building. Students who accept their offer are accepting their specific assignment. Requests to transfer buildings or rooms are not accepted following acceptance of an offer or after moving in.

If you decline your offer or your offer expires, then your application will automatically be cancelled. You will need to contact the Housing office if you wish to have your application reactivated and placed on a waiting list.

If you are traveling and cannot be contacted during the summer, it is your responsibility to contact the Housing office and check your offer status in order to meet your acceptance deadline. Failure to meet your acceptance deadline will result in cancellation of your residence offer and your application will be returned to the waitlist.

If you do not receive a residence offer by July 31st, then you should contact us to let us know if you are still interested in remaining on our waiting list in case there are any late cancellations.
