

**Housing Services – Undergraduate Residences
Frequently Asked Questions About CUPE 3903 Labour Disruption
Update 02.02.09**

1. Can I stay in my room during the extension of winter term?

Yes - you can stay in your residence room until 24 hours after your final winter term exam.

2. Will I have to pay extra to stay and finish the winter term?

No - you will not have to pay extra room fees for the extended winter term.

3. Will my meal plan still be valid?

Yes – the expiry date for 2008-2009 Meal Plans has been extended to June 2, 2009. Any remaining balance in the Meal Plan account will expire after June 2 and is non-refundable.

4. What will happen to summer residence?

Summer residence will be available for June, July and August and applications will be available April 1st.

5. What if I want to withdraw from university and leave residence at the end of the fall term? Will I get a refund?

You should visit the Housing office to complete a form indicating that you are withdrawing from residence and the university. Once we have confirmed your de-enrolment, then you will have 24 hours to check out of your room and return your keys to Housing. You will be refunded 1/2 of your room fees if you move out before the beginning of winter term. Additionally, Housing will not charge the \$500 cancellation fee for early termination of your agreement but will charge a \$100 administrative fee to refill your space.

6. What if I want to move out of residence but I remain enrolled at the university?

Your Undergraduate Residence Agreement remains in effect and you will continue to be financially responsible for your room until Housing finds another eligible student to take over the agreement for your room.
