A message from the York Federation of Students (YFS)

The York Federation of Students (YFS), your central students' union, would like to remind you that as a full-time university student in Toronto, you qualify for a Post-Secondary Student Discounted TTC Metropass!

Established in 2010 after city-wide student action, members now have a \$99 monthly Metropass – saving you \$22 of the regular price! However, in order to be eligible for the discount, you must receive a Post-Secondary TTC Student Photo Identification Card. This card must be presented upon the purchase of every Metropass, and shown to TTC operators when entering buses, subways and streetcars.

The photo identification cards cost \$7 per year and are made on campus. Each card is valid until October 31 of the following year. You must be a full-time registered student to be eligible for the discount.

Procedures to obtain a TTC photo identification Card:

1. *Students must pre-register at the Data Card website.*

2. *Obtain your photo identification.*

- Your York University student card.
- A printed copy of your course timetable to prove full-time student status.

Alternatively, students may also obtain their photo identification from the TTC Sherbourne Station Photo ID Centre's hours of operation are Monday-Friday 3-7 p.m., Saturday 10 a.m.-4 p.m. (closed Sundays and Statutory Holidays).
