## Summer School

Students attending summer school are encouraged to submit midterm grades to the Office of the Registrar as soon as they are available.

## Community Service Hours

Students are encouraged to complete their community service hours by the end of the last day of secondary school classes.

## Calculation of Secondary Averages

All programs require a minimum admission average which may change depending on the number of applicants. A second average is considered for students applying to the following programs:

- Computer Science - average of math courses (70\%).
- Nursing - average of chemistry and biology ( $75 \%$ ).

Engineering - average of all science and math courses except biology (74\%)

- Science - average of all attempted science and math courses excludin data management ( $70 \%$ ).
- Forensics - average of all required science and math courses (70\%)


## lanuary Admissions

The university will make offers of admission for students wishing to begin studies in most, if not all programs, based on space availability

## Upgrading of Course

The highest grade is used in the calculation. Students who have completed their secondary school diploma and choose to upgrade courses following their diploma and apply for admission to the following fall entrance semester with the University of Windsor will still be eligible for automatic entrance awards. Students who have completed their secondary school diploma and are away from school for the fall and winter semesters will not be eligible for entrance awards.

## Admission Update for IB Students

The University of Windsor may grant advanced standing for students who enter the university with an International Baccalaureate diploma. For admission to first year: Full diploma must be completed with passes in six subjects with at least three at the Higher Level and with a grade total of at least 24 and no mark less than 4 . In addition, the candidates must meet the prerequisites specific to the faculty to which they are neeking admission For transfer credit IBD applicants who have successfully completed the fill diploma with a grade total of 28 or more celusive of additional points which may be awarded for the sucessfil leio fle may completion of the Extended Essay and Theory of Knowledge) may be ranted a sean election, for each Hi ( $80-89 \%$ ) or better, for a maximum of 4 general elective course credits
