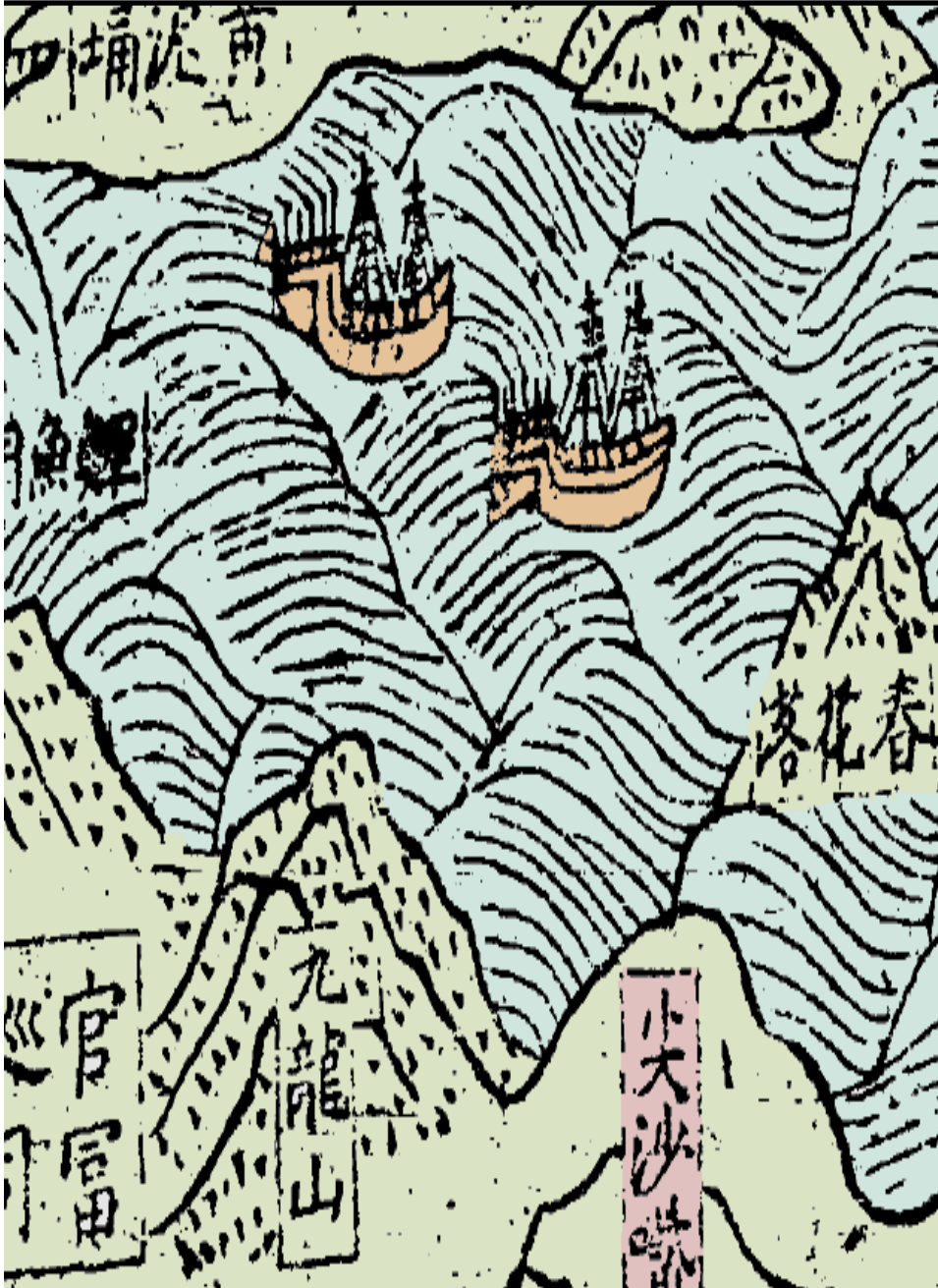


Biography and the History of Hong Kong
