

## Printable Prompts for Sonic Exploration Recipe Box

### FIELD TRIP ACTIVITY

Visit Herb Carnegie's old neighbourhood and make note of the important landmarks he mentions in his book. How has the sonic landscape of the area changed? What has remained the same?

### FIELD TRIP ACTIVITY

Explore the sounds you hear in a place where you can play hockey.

### OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES

Listen for the sounds of playing and games by both humans and non-humans. Who is playing? What are they playing?  
What are the rules of the game?

### OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES

Create a map of the area around you.

What sounds do hear?

Put them on the map where you heard them.

Place important events, people and places on the map.

### FIELD TRIP ACTIVITY

Map and visit the places where Herb Carnegie played hockey.

What do they sound like now?

"No longer would I hear skates cutting the ice or hear pucks smashing against the boards and no longer would I hear the applause of fans. In their stead however, I would hear young voices: "Daddy can you fix my bicycle?" "Daddy can I ... ?" "Daddy?" "Daddy! ";"(Carnegie, 2012 p.148)
