

Campus Status System

The campus status system supports daily operations within each reopening phase. The following chart highlights select operational areas.

Epidemiology and Public Health Capacity	High and/or growing levels of community transmission; multiple cases locally and on campus. Community Safety	Community Safety provides regular 24/7 and 365-day services across all phases of reopening.		
University IT Supports and Services	Very limited services available on-campus. In-person classroom support dictated by on-campus classes.	Reduced services available on campus. In-person classroom support dictated by on-campus classes.	Full range of supports/services available by appointment and walk-in within applicable public health regulations.
Student Advising, Supports and Accessibility Services	Limited in-person/on-campus appointment-based student advising, counselling, supports and services (no in-person walk-ins). Virtual appointment-based and virtual drop-in advising sessions available.	In-person/on-campus appointment-based student advising, counselling, supports and services (no in-person walk-ins) encouraged. Virtual appointment-based and virtual drop-in advising sessions available. Libraries	Access limited to study space on an exceptional needs basis only. Virtual services and supports available. All other onsite access services suspended. Food Services	All applicable public health measures and government directives for indoor and outdoor dining will be strictly observed across all phases of reopening.
