About The YorkU TD Community Engagement Centre

Supported by a ten-year gift from TD Financial Group, the York University-TD Community Engagement Centre (CEC) was created to establish “the foundation for a highly visible pan-university teaching, research and resource facility that will benefit students, faculty and the community-at-large” within the Black-Creek community.

Upon announcement of the gift award in 2006, a comprehensive consultation and planning process was undertaken in 2007 resulting in the identification of the following primary purposes of the CEC:

- To encourage mutual university-community participation in learning, research and community service aimed at capacity building
- To facilitate information sharing between the community and university
- To facilitate university-community partnership
- To facilitate access to university information and resources

The CEC was officially launched in September 2008 alongside the launch of the President’s Task Force on Community Engagement. While originally housed within the Atkinson Faculty of Liberal and Professional Studies, responsibility for the CEC was transferred to the Vice-President Academic & Provost in 2009 (reporting to the Vice Provost Academic).

Application Tips & Tricks

✓ Understanding What Scholarship Committees Look For

- Review the scholarship's criteria and mission statement
- Highlight academic achievements or improvement over time
- Showcase leadership roles (clubs, sports, volunteering, etc.)
- Demonstrate community service involvement
- Clearly outline career goals and ambitions

✓ Writing a Strong Essay

- Read and fully understand the essay prompt
- Use personal stories and real-life examples
- Keep your writing clear, concise, and engaging
- Avoid generic responses—make it unique
- Proofread for grammar, spelling, and clarity

✓ Strengthening Your Application

- Follow instructions carefully
- Submit all required documents (transcripts, letters, etc.)
- Get strong recommendation letters from teachers or mentors
- Emphasize how the scholarship will help you achieve your goals
- Use confident and positive language

✓ Making Your Application Stand Out

- Apply early to avoid last-minute stress
- Tailor your application to match the scholarship's values
- Double-check all information before submitting
- Apply for multiple scholarships to increase chances
- Seek feedback from a teacher, mentor, or friend

✓ Tips for Average Students

- Look for scholarships that focus on leadership, service, or unique experiences
- Highlight strengths beyond academics (skills, challenges overcome, creativity)
- Search for scholarships with fewer applicants to boost chances
- Stay persistent—keep applying even after rejections
