Flying high (in the competitive sky): The role of airports in an age of globalized regionalism

Jean-Paul Addie is a PhD candidate in the Department of Geography at York University. His doctoral dissertation provides a critical comparative analysis of urban governance and transportation infrastructure in Chicago and Toronto from 1909-2010. His work has been published in *Environment and Planning A*, *Local Economy*, and *Urban Geography*.
