She is the author of *South Koreans in the Debt Crisis: The Creation of a Neoliberal Welfare Society* and the editor of *New Millennium South Korea: Neoliberal Capitalism and Transnational Movements*. She is a South Korean specialist, trained in socio-cultural anthropology and women/gender/sexuality studies. Her research interests include (neo)liberalization, policing family, homelessness, young adult's unemployment, residential autonomy of unmarried women, psychological health support system, speculations, care labor, social movement, and migration.
