Workshop: Publishing on the CVR Web Site

You may have noticed some recent changes to the CVR web site. As part of this progress, we have installed a system called WebPal, which allows every member of the CVR to edit their own homepage under [cvr.yorku.ca/members](http://cvr.yorku.ca/members).

WebPal has been a development of our new Spin-off company Palomino Inc., in an effort to create a system which enables quick and easy maintenance of research-related information.

In a practical workshop, I will explain how to use WebPal to:

- quicly add your own content to the CVR web site

- publish media such as pdfs, images, movies
- keep an up-to-date, online resume
