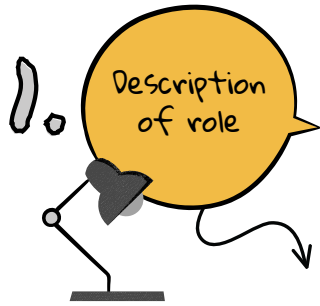


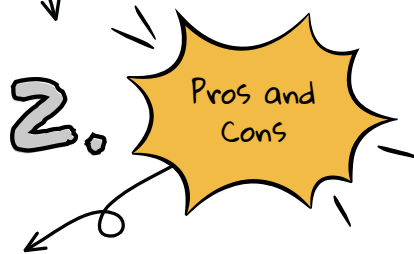
# Librarian

Interested in becoming a librarian? Here's what you'll need to know!



1. **Description of role**  
Research, helps student find books journals and online resources, consultations, help students run research method classes, purchasing library materials.

**Best Part:** Getting to help students and faculty members get access to the different resources they need  
**Challenge:** Having to decide how funds will be distributed (can lead to having to say no to faculty members)



2. **Pros and Cons**  
Individuals must have a Masters of Library and Information Science (MLIS) degree that is accredited by the American Library Association (ALA)



Universities that offer this in Ontario: Western University, University of Toronto, McGill University



3. **Formal Training**
1. Volunteer and put your time into getting experience working hands-on in the field.
  2. Follow your heart.
  3. Attend information studies and talk to people within the field.
