What does a Professor Do?


- Teach students a variety of academic and vocational subjects, based on their specialization
- Develop a curriculm for their courses and plan lessons
- Evaluate student's work and progress by grading assignments and tests/exams





- Ensure that teaching methods meet the curriculum and university standards
- Mentor and encourage teaching assistants
- Conduct and publish their own research to continue to show proficency in their field or area of specialization





- Stay informed about any changes or new developments to thier field of study and be able to revise lesson plans and materials
- Supervise graduate students doing any research





- Offer accomodations and mental health support to students
- Collaborate with colleagues, faculty staff and adminstrators to help with student recruitment, course design, and more

Step-By-Step Journey

Get a Bachelors Degree

Getting a bachelor's degree in a chosen subject area is the first step to becoming a university professor. Figure out what it is that you would want to spend your whole life continuing to learn about. For example, if you have a passion for learning math, you might want to do an undergrad in a math related program.



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Get Work Experience as a Student



During your graduate years, participate in any assistantships that your university allows you to. This could be a research opportunity which allows you to get work experience and volunteer hours or it could be a teaching assistantship, where you help grade tests/exams and assignments. Experience is great for aspiring professors!

Get a Masters Degree

Getting a graduate degree is the next step for aspiring professors. Choose a subject area that you would like to specialize in and excel in it.





Get a Ph.D.



Getting a Ph.D. is the next step to becoming a university professor. You will need to complete coursework as well as write thesis on a topic of your choice and present your research to a committee to receive your Ph.D. Having a Ph.D. shows your expertise in a subject area.

Excellent communication skills for lecturing students and communicating with colleagues




Time management skills to balance work and personal life
