- Every day is different dealing with students, exciting to some

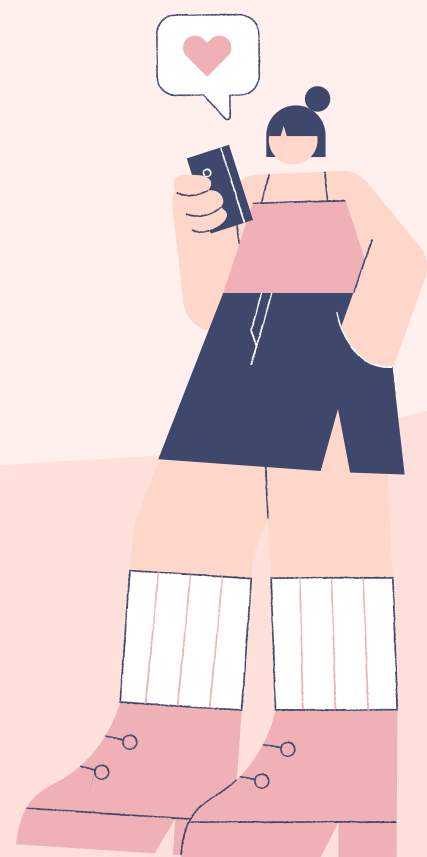
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CHALLENGES OF ROLE

- Dealing with rational adults who can retaliate



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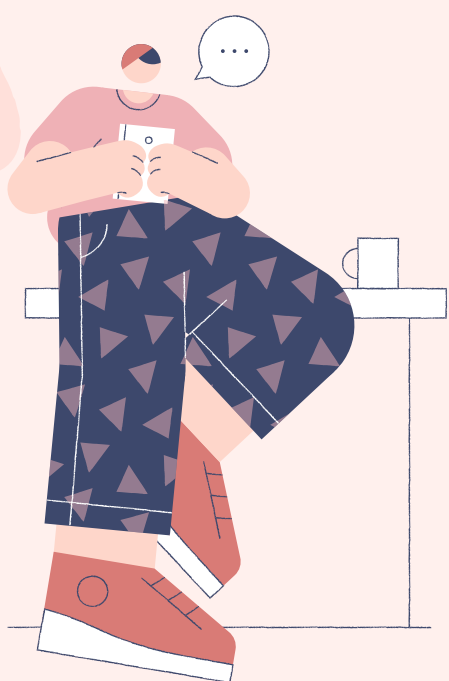
TYPICAL DAY/WEEK

ADVICE

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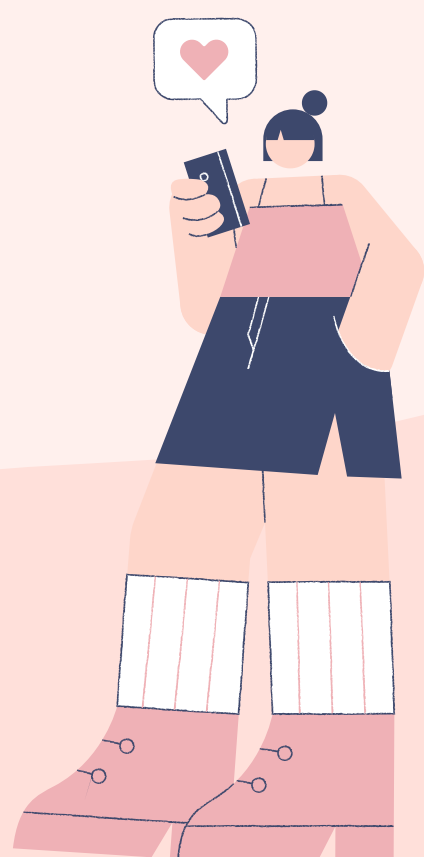
- This is a great role for an individual who enjoys working with students
