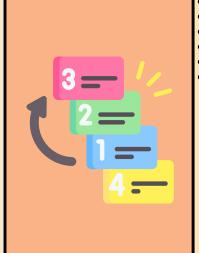


QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

QUALITIES REQUIRED

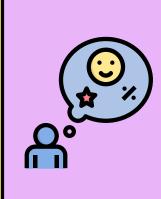
- Open minded

- Teachers prioritizing content over pedagogy



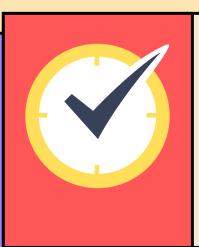
WHAT TO EXPECT?
