



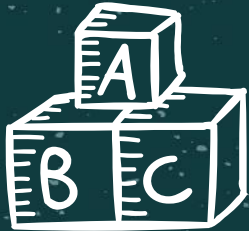

## ABOUT YOURSELF

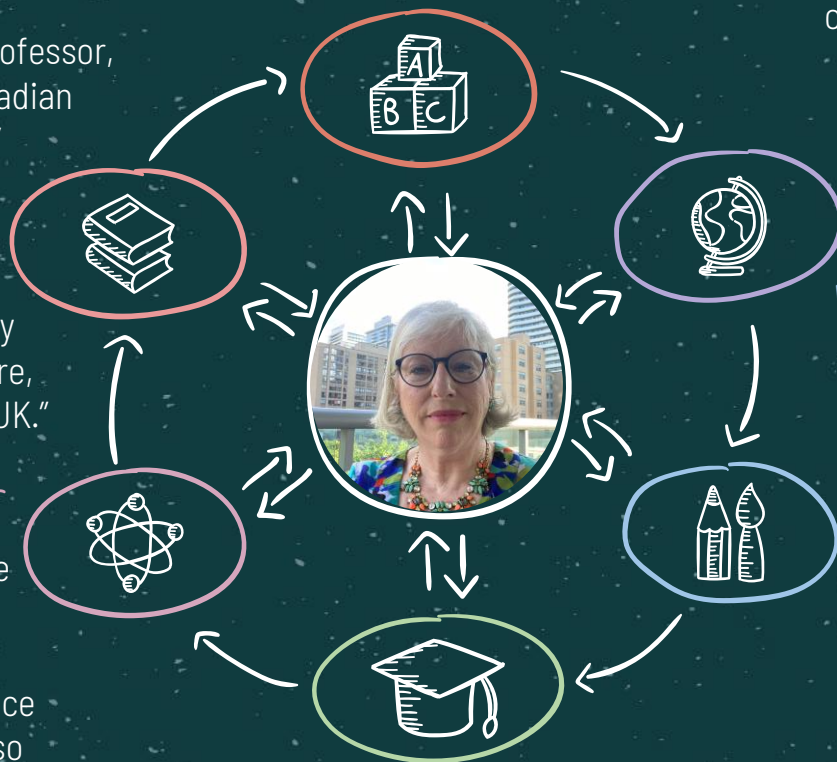
"I am a professor in the Faculty of Education. My title is Associate Professor, Teaching Stream. I am British Canadian and have family in both countries."

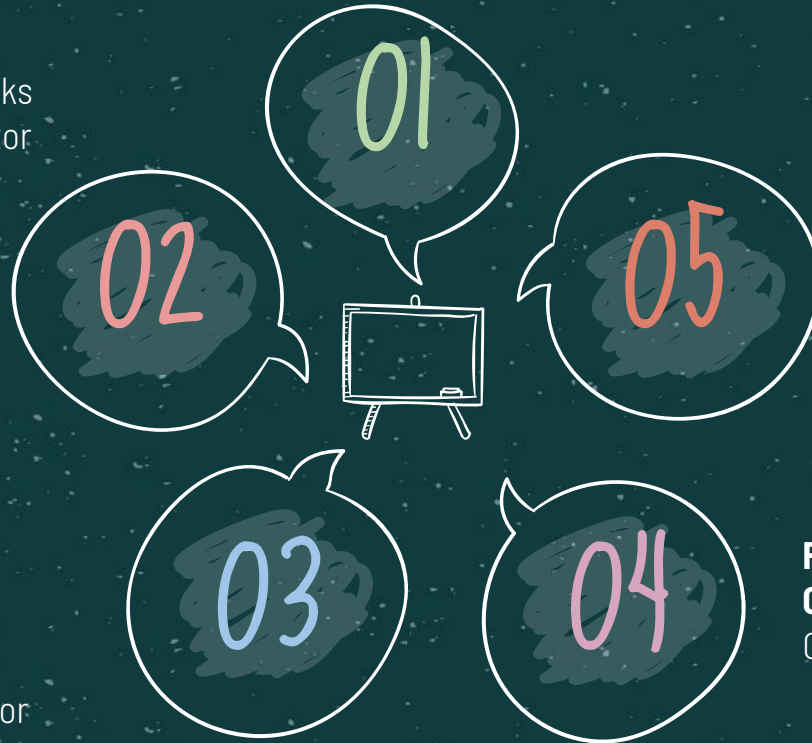

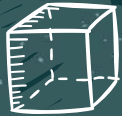

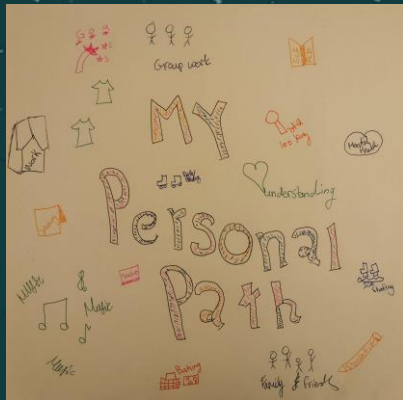
The opportunity to see what activities work and how collaboration is an amazing tool with students of all ages.

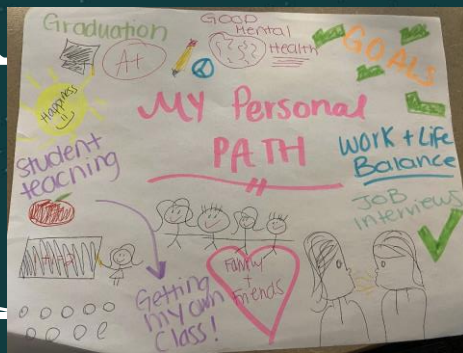
As a teacher we will always be presenting to a class of students everyday so this was a great experience that helped me with those important skills.



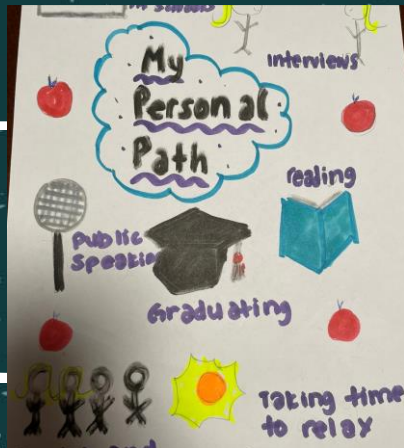
