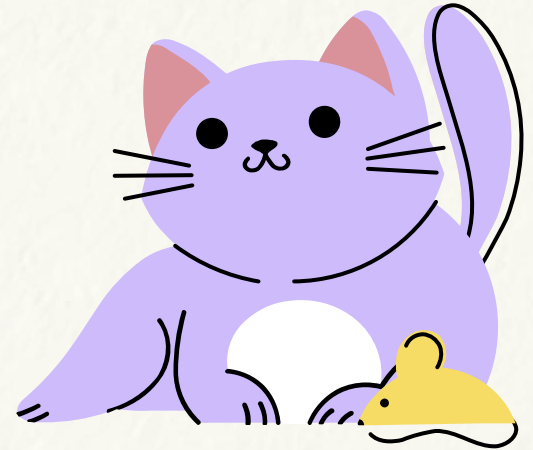
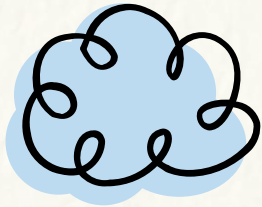

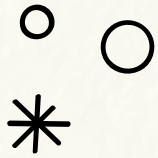


# Introduction: Ontario SPCA

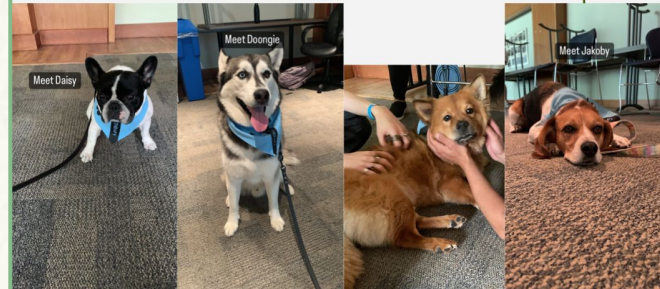

## Collaboration

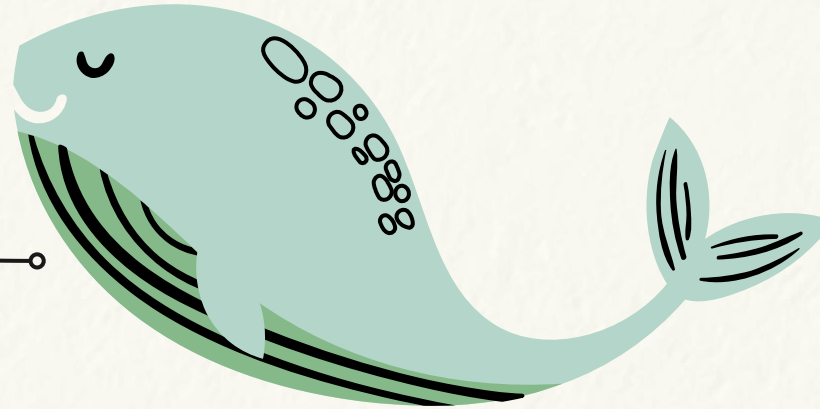
We learnt how to work with people with different backgrounds, skill sets, perspectives and leveraged each other's strengths.

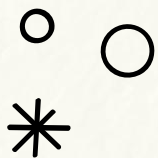
## Communication
