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DOs!!

- → Allow for smaller group discussions
 - More discussions based on student opinions
 - Focusing on a concise workload/lectures
 - Gather student feedback; either weekly or bi-weekly



DOs!

Start the class with interactive activities/welcoming space

- Anonymous polls, jam boards, music playing
- ♦ Have visuals (presentation) prepared
- Should include a bit of colour and pictures in it
- Include short videos or activities to stimulate students

CAMERA ALTERNATIVES!!

- → Make avatars (interactive activity)
- → Selfies for profile pics (requirement)
- → Giving students credit for turning on their cameras is an excellent way to encourage them to turn on their cameras





- Speaking for too long
 - Not having a prepared script to guide the conversation during class time
 - students feeling lost
 - Long breaks between lessons
 - result in the students becoming distracted,
 - losing focus.
