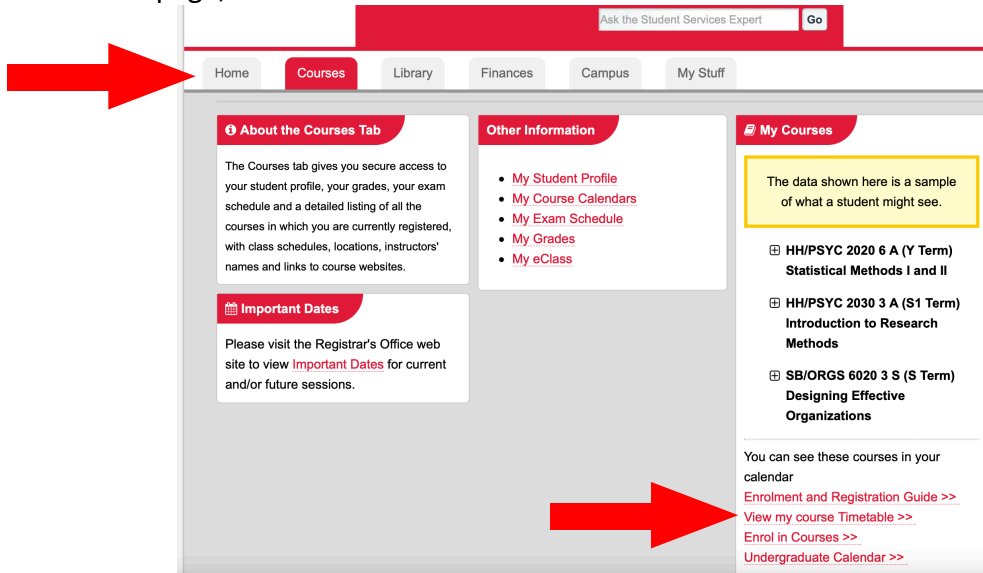


Students: Finding Course Offerings and Classroom Information

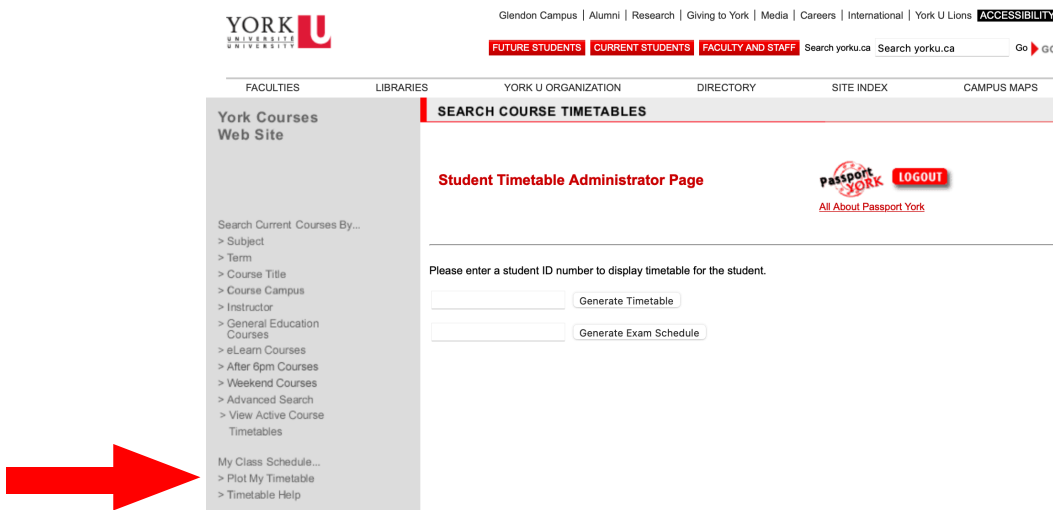

Course information is now behind the firewall. In order to find your course information, follow these steps:

1. Go to <https://my.yorku.ca/group/home/home> and log in with your Passport York.
2. On the homepage, click on the “Courses Tab”.



3. At the bottom of this page, click on “View my course Timetable.”
4. Using the options on the left-hand sidebar, click on “Plot my Timetable.”



5. Alternatively, in order to see course information, click on Subject in the left-hand bar, then select the Term and select the Subject (EDUC):

a. Guide to course information:

i. Term:

- F = Fall
- W = Winter
- Y = Year-long

ii. Type:

- SEMR and LECT = in-person, on-campus
- BLEN = Blended; combination of online and in-person/on-campus
- ONLN = fully online
 - a. If there is a day/time indicated, the class is synchronous

- b. If there is no day/time indicated, the class is asynchronous
- iii. Day:
- M = Monday
 - T = Tuesday
 - W = Wednesday
 - R = Thursday
 - F = Friday
 - S = Saturday
- iv. Start time:
- This time uses the 24-hour clock
- v. Duration:
- This number refers to the number of minutes. 180 minutes = 3 hours
- vi. Location:
- This information includes the [building acronym](#) and the room number.
- vii. Campus:
- This information indicates the campus. If it is not listed (or if it says “OC,” which means “off-campus”), please check in the Course Notes at the end of this row.
