



## **Failure to Submit Annual Progress Report**

Every student in the Graduate Program in Interdisciplinary Studies is required to submit an Annual Progress Report to the Graduate Program Assistant by April 15<sup>th</sup>. This Progress Report must include substantive written comments by both the student her/himself **and** the coordinating supervisor. The form must then be signed by all three committee members and the student.

Students facing difficulty coordinating a committee meeting in order to facilitate completion of the *Interdisciplinary Studies Annual Progress Report* must notify / meet with the director prior to the April 15<sup>th</sup> deadline.

Failure to submit an Annual Progress Report by April 15<sup>th</sup> will result in the placement of an automated enrollment block. Students are well-advised to book an early April Committee meeting at the start of the academic year.
