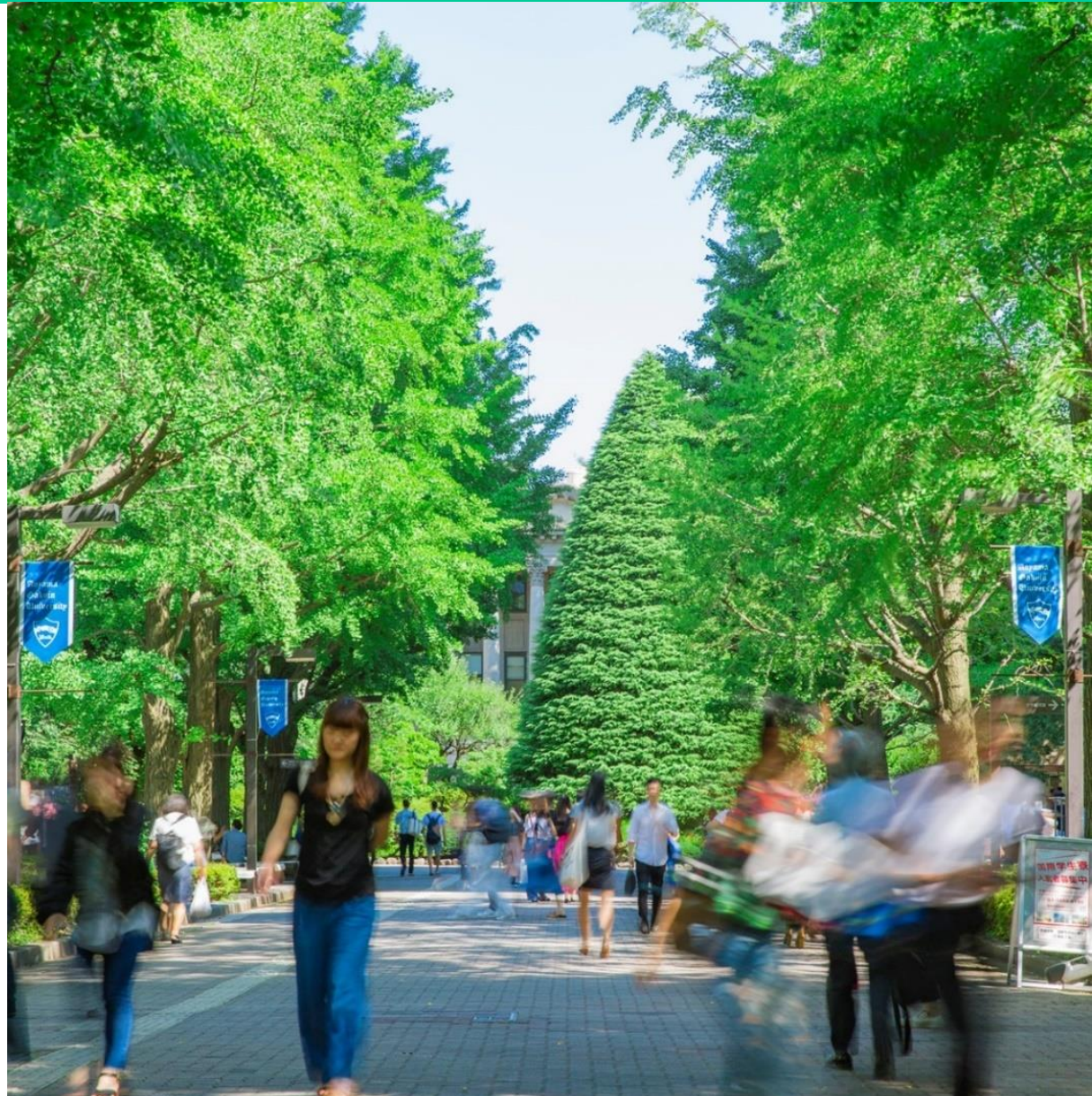

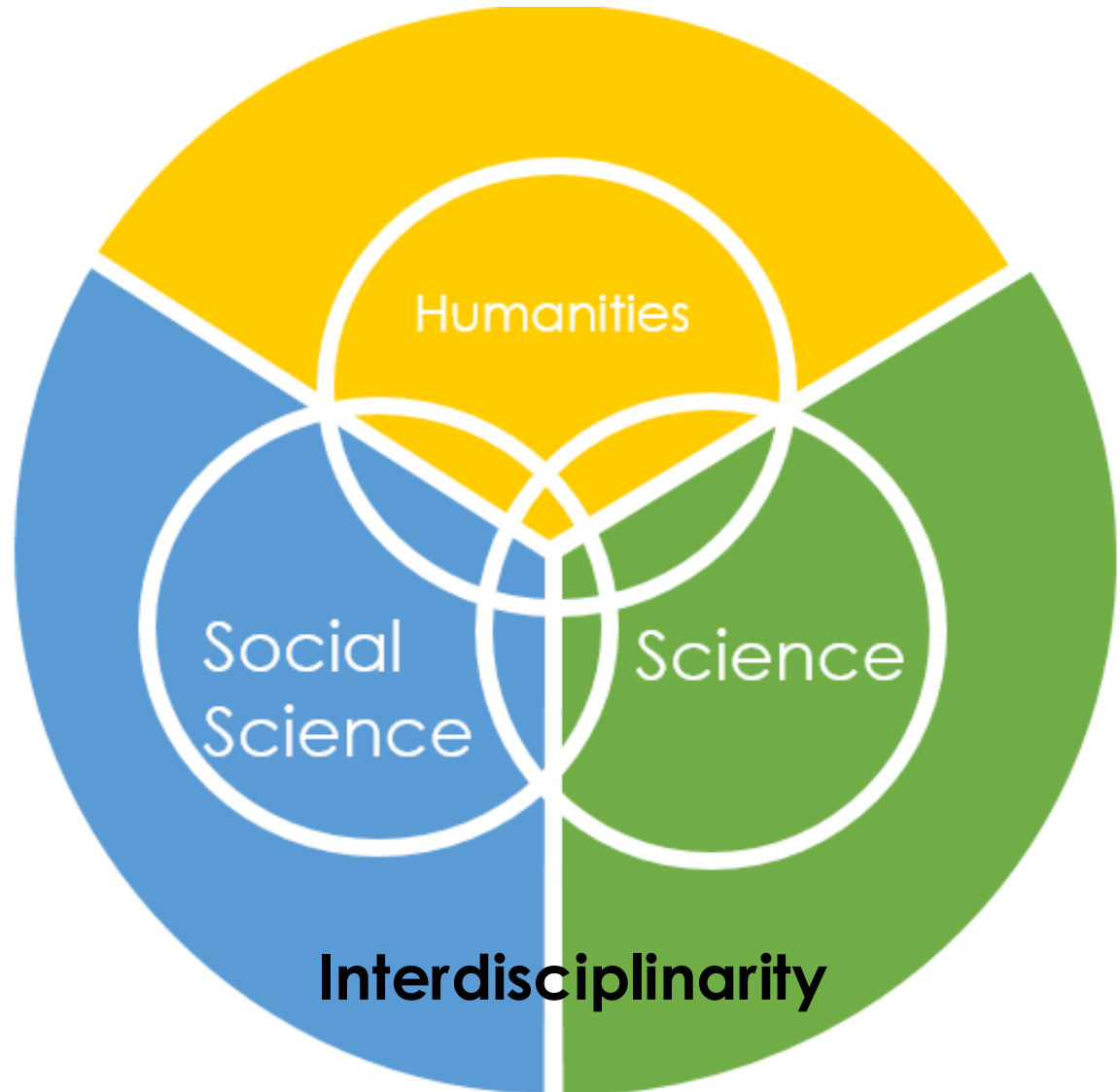
We have taken to heart the spirit of “the salt of the Earth,” the idea of public service that is the foundation of our university to encourage each other to work together to effect change locally and internationally.

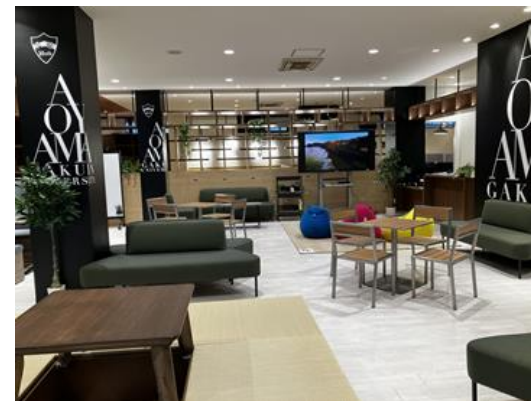


Many Opportunities for Cultural Exchange
