Students may also fulfil this requirement through courses outside the English major if those courses contain a significant literary component and if the student obtains the written permission of the Program Coordinator.

Additional Notes:

Requirement Checklist and Notes (to ensure graduation, each box must be checked ‘completed’)

- Residency Requirement:** a minimum of 30 course credits and at least half (50 per cent) of the course credits required in each undergraduate degree program major/minor must be taken at York University.
- Upper-Level Requirement:** at least 36 credits at the 3000 or 4000 level, including at least 18 credits at the 4000 level.
- Cumulative grade point average** of at least 5.00.

NOTE: For the **GENERAL EDUCATION** category, a minimum of 6 credits must be chosen from each of Humanities, Natural Science and Social Science. General Education courses are offered at the 1000 level. A maximum of 9 credits in Humanities and Social Science will count towards fulfillment of the General Education 21 credit requirements.
