1. To list AP/JP3080 3.00 Food, Foodways, and the Japanese Language: A Linguistics Perspective as one of the optional courses that satisfy the 36-credit-requirement for the Honours Minor Degree Program in Japanese Studies.

2. This newly approved course was first offered successfully in the Fall of 2017. The addition of the course will positively affect the program because it adds another degree-credit option at the upper level in an area of increasing importance in cultural studies and linguistic studies. It also complements and conforms to the methodologies employed in other courses at this level in the Japanese section.
