REQUIREMENTS FOR CHILDREN'S STUDIES MAJORS AND MINORS

1. Students wishing to major in *Children's Studies* must make an advising appointment with the Program Coordinator by contacting the *Children's Studies Program* Secretary at 416-736-2100 extension 33214. Continuing Majors and Minors are also encouraged to make an advising appointment each year.
2. *Children's Studies Program* core courses need to be taken in sequence, one at a time. Students need at least a "B" in HUMA 1970 6.0A before taking HUMA 2690 6.0A; at least a "B" in HUMA 2690 6.0A before taking HUMA 3695 6.0; and at least a "B" in HUMA 3695 6.0.
3. To graduate with an Honours BA, student's cumulative grade point average (GPA) on all courses taken at York must be at least a "C+" (5.0).
4. For purposes of meeting program requirements, 9-credit Foundations courses will count as 6 credits towards the major; the additional 3 credits can be applied to "Free Choice Courses."
5. Faculty of Liberal Arts & Professional Studies students may complete a maximum of three 9-credit Foundations courses for degree credit.
6. **Upper Level Credits: Faculty of Liberal Arts & Professional Studies regulations require that in order to obtain an Honours BA (120 credits), students must take a total of at least 36 credits at the 3000-level or 4000-level, including at least 18 credits at the 4000 level, including at least 12 credits at the 4000-level in each Honours Major or Specialized Honours Major.**

NOTES:

To meet the upper level requirement, students need to take at least 6 credits at 3000 or 4000 level AND at least 6 credits at 4000 level BEYOND the upper level requirements in the CHST major (that is, instead of the 24 credits at the upper level, including at least 12 credits at the 4000 level required by CHST major, students must have a total of at least 36 credits at the upper level with at least 18 credits at the 4000 level).
