REQUIREMENTS FOR CHILDREN'S STUDIES MAJORS AND MINORS

1. Students wishing to minor in *Children's Studies* must make an advising appointment with the Program Coordinator by contacting the *Children's Studies Program* Secretary at 416-736-2100 extension 33214. Continuing Minors are also encouraged to make an advising appointment each year.

2. *Children's Studies Program* core courses will normally be taken in sequence, one in each year of the program. HUMA 1970 9.0A must always precede any other core courses. In special circumstances, with the approval of the Program Coordinator, it may be possible to take HUMA 2690 and HUMA 3695 at the same time or to take HUMA 3695 and HUMA 4142 at the same time.

3. To graduate with an Honours BA, student's cumulative grade point average (GPA) on all courses taken at York must be at least a "C+" (5.0).

4. For purposes of meeting program requirements, 9-credit Foundations courses will count as 6 credits towards the major; the additional 3 credits can be applied to "Free Choice Courses."

5. Faculty of Liberal Arts & Professional Studies students may complete a maximum of three 9credit Foundations courses for degree credit. Students who need to complete more than three Foundations courses in order to fulfill program (major or minor) course requirements may do so with permission of the *Children's Studies Program* Coordinator.

6. Upper Level Credits: Faculty of Liberal Arts & Professional Studies regulations require that in order to obtain an Honours BA (120 credits), students must take a total of at least 36 credits at the 3000-level or 4000-level, including at least 18 credits at the 4000 level, including at least 12 credits at the 4000-level in each Honours Major or Specialized Honours Major.
