#### **Graduating with a certificate:**

To qualify for the Cross-Disciplinary Certificate in Children's Literature, Students must complete 24 credits, 18 of which are at the 2000-level or above, including 18 credits at the 3000-or 4000-level, with the requirement of a cumulative grade point average in these 24 credits of at least 5.00 (C+). \*\*At least 12 of the credits counted toward the certificate requirements must be in addition to those used to satisfy the requirements of the undergraduate program major.

#### **Graduating with a degree and certificate simultaneously:**

Certificates will not be conferred until candidates have successfully completed an undergraduate degree program if they are simultaneously enrolled in a degree and a certificate program. The Faculty does not award certificates retroactively. Refer to
