The Qualitative Accounting Research Symposium (QARS) brings together researchers and accounting faculty who share an interest in qualitative accounting research from diverse methodological and theoretical perspectives. The Symposium provides a high-profile forum for scholars (academics, research students) and practitioners to discuss accounting practice and research issues in a social, political, and economic context of humankind.

Presentation formats

There will be two formats for presentations. Both in-person and remote presentation opportunities are available.

- Full paper presentations – 30 minutes consisting of a 15-minute author presentation, an up to 10-minute discussant presentation, and the remaining time for Q&A
- Lightning presentations – 15 minutes consisting of a 5-minute author presentation and a combined Q&A session

Submissions

The Symposium welcomes submissions of qualitative research projects in any area of accounting. Please note that regardless of the language of submission, all presentations will be conducted in English.

- *Full paper submissions:* Papers may be submitted in English, French, or Spanish and must be in Word format. Paper submissions must include an abstract of 250 words or less. Author identification should appear on the cover page only. The title should appear on the abstract page and on the first page of the body of the paper.

Lightning submissions: Project summary or extended abstract submissions (max. two pages) will be considered for one of the available “lightning” presentation slots. The lightning sessions will be immediately followed by group discussions.

During the submission process, you will be asked to declare that the paper is original work and that at the time of submission, it has not been accepted for publication. You will also be asked to agree that you and/or a co-author will review up to two other papers, and that you or a co-author will be a discussant for another paper if your paper is accepted and presented.

Deadlines

IMPORTANT NOTE: Please be advised that the paper/abstract submission deadline for this year's symposium will be Friday, September 6, 2024, about a month earlier than it has been in prior years. To submit, please visit our website:

Notification of acceptance will be sent to authors by Monday, September 30, 2024.

This year's Symposium will feature a keynote speaker, a panel discussion, full paper presentations and lightning sessions for research projects. The Symposium will be preceded by an Emerging Scholars Colloquium (ESC) to support emerging scholars working on qualitative accounting research. The ESC will give emerging scholars an opportunity to present and discuss their research projects with senior qualitative researchers within a relatively informal atmosphere. The ESC will take place on November 27, 2024, preceding the QARS on November 28-29, 2024, which ESC participants are encouraged to attend. Qualitative Research and the process of (dis-)locating Silence and Secrecy
