He started his career at York University in the Department of Political Science in 1985 after working in the Alberta Public Service for four years. He helped found the <u>School of Public Policy and</u> Administration in 2006 and was the founding Director of



the <u>Master of Public Policy</u>, <u>Administration and Law Program</u> from 2006 to 2009. He was the head of <u>McLaughlin College</u> from 2004 to 2009, and from 2011 to 2013 when he retired.
