#### Requirement Checklist and Notes (To ensure graduation, each box must be checked 'completed')

□ Residency Requirement: a minimum of 30 course credits and at least half (50 per cent) of the course credits required in each undergraduate degree program major/minor must be taken at York University

□ Upper-level Requirement: at least 36 credits at the 3000-4000 level. 18 credits must be at the 4000 level

NOTE#1: The Honours BA program in East Asian Studies requires students to take at least 42 credits in East Asian Studies, including at least one core course and at least 12 credits (other than language/translation courses) at the 4000 level. Demonstrated competence in an East Asian language (Chinese or Japanese or Korean) at the intermediate level is required. This requirement would normally be met by successful completion of AP/CH 2000 6.0 or AP/JP 2000 6.0 or AP/KOR 2000 6.0. It may also be met by passing a competency test, or by successful completion of another course recognized for the purpose

NOTE #2: For the <u>GENERAL EDUCATION</u> category, a minimum of 6.0 credits must be chosen from each of Humanities, Natural Science and Social Science. General Education courses are offered at the 1000 level. A maximum of 9 credits in Humanities and Social Science will count towards fulfillment of the General Education 21 credit requirements.
