

EXPLORE YU CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

The Faculty of Liberal Arts & Professional Studies (LA&PS) at York University is excited to welcome your camper to the Explore YU - Summer 2024 for a fun, memorable, adventurous, and safe experience! Each camper has a responsibility to act and behave in a way that ensures a positive experience in order to protect the health and safety of all campers on campus. **The Camper Code of Conduct must be followed by all Explore YU campers.**

BEHAVIOUR GUIDELINES

- All campers are accountable for their words and actions while attending camp.
- All campers must be respectful of others and spaces, including other people's property.
- All campers must follow LA&PS faculty and staff's directions.

PROHIBITED BEHAVIOURS

- Endangering their own and other campers' health and safety, as well as the health and safety of instructors, staff, and/or student employees at York University.
- Taking, destroying, or failing to protect the University and other camper's personal property.
- Continual disruption of the program.
- Failure to comply with the Camper Code of Conduct and instructions.
- Refusal to participate in activities and cooperate with staff.
- Inappropriate physical contact.
- Using profanity or abusive language or exhibiting offensive attire or other personal items.
- Bullying, aggressive, or violent behaviours.
- Possession or use of illegal substances, tobacco, or alcohol.
- Possession of weapons – any object that has the potential to cause harm to another or make another person worry for their safety may be considered a weapon.
- Leaving the premises without giving notice to the International Student Success & Engagement Coordinator or Manager, International Student Success & Engagement.

DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES

When a camper violates the Camper Code of Conduct, we shall take the following actions:

1. The International Student Success & Engagement Coordinator or Manager, International Student Success & Engagement will redirect the camper to more appropriate behaviours.
2. If inappropriate behaviour persists, campers will be reminded of the Camper Code of Conduct, requested to correct the behaviour, and their parents and/or guardians will be contacted.
3. If the camper's inappropriate behaviour persists, the International Student Success & Engagement Coordinator or Manager, International Student Success & Engagement will notify the respective parents and/or guardians, and the camper will be dismissed from the camp for the rest of the program.
