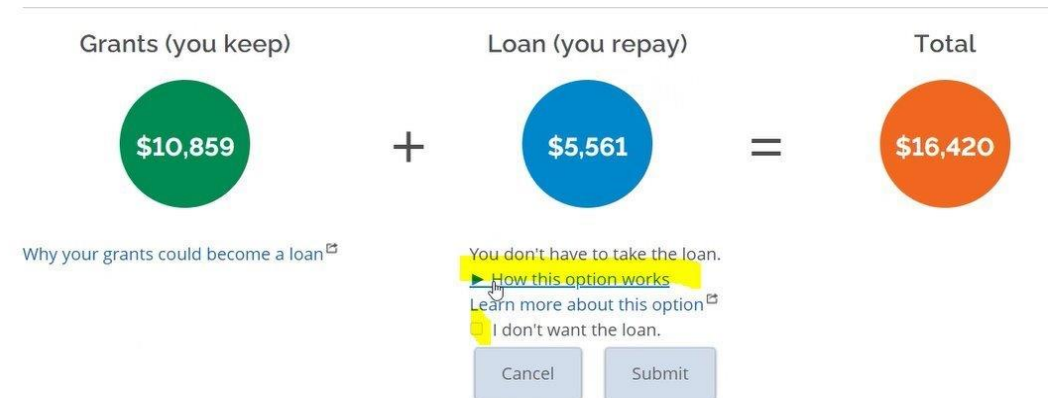
What is OSAP?



Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP):

OSAP is an application-based government aid program for Ontario resident students, Canadian citizens, permanent residents and protected persons. Based on the government's assessment of each student's educational costs and expected financial resources, OSAP offers a mixture of grants (money students may not need to repay) as well as repayable loans.

The OSAP Aid Estimator can provide you with a rough estimate of the funding that you may be eligible for, through OSAP:



OSAP Grants vs Loans

- › OSAP is a financial aid program offered jointly by the provincial and federal governments. Funding is available in the form of grants and loans.
- › Students who apply for OSAP may qualify for grants only, loans only, or a combination of grants and loans.
- › OSAP federal loans are interest free.
- › OSAP provincial loans are not interest free. Interest is charged on provincial loans immediately after the student exits school.
- › OSAP loans are payable to the National Student Loans Service Centre (NSLSC). Students receive advance notice from NSLSC informing them when payments are due.
- › When an OSAP application is approved, (grant and/or loan) funds are remitted to YorkU. Any surplus for that academic term/year will be sent to the student's bank account once they've provided their banking information.



Financial Aid, Awards, and Scholarships

The Financial Aid, Awards, and Scholarships (FAAS):

York university student support application system for scholarships, awards, bursaries and on-campus employment programs. Completion of the Student Profile in FAAS allows students to be considered for funding opportunities. Students will be automatically matched to awards they meet the criteria for.

Students must apply for full-time OSAP extensions (Winter and/or Summer) on FAAS.

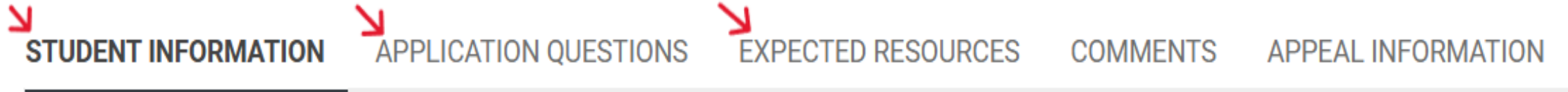

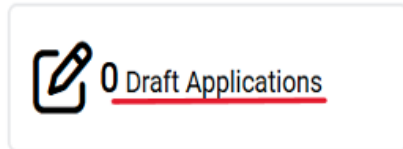

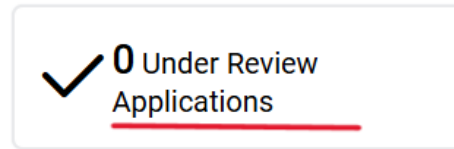

Summer OSAP Extension Process

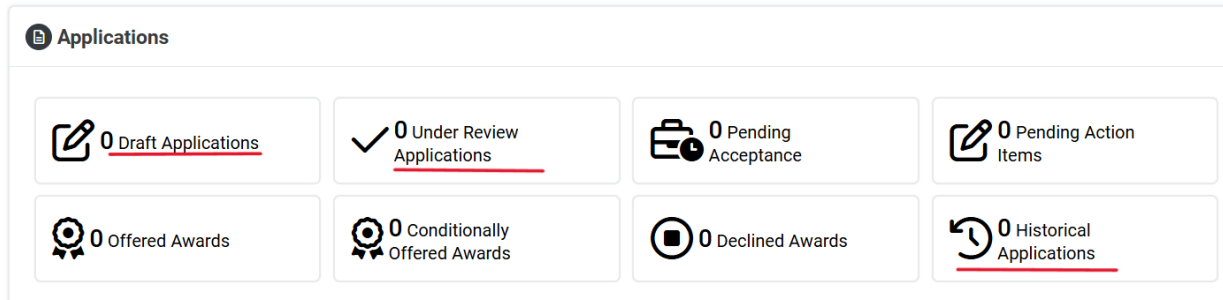
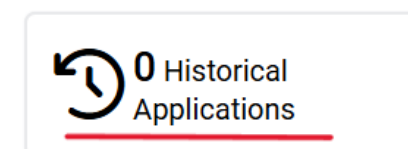
OSAP extension applications that have not been submitted will appear under “Draft Applications”.



Successfully submitted OSAP extension applications will appear in “Under Review Applications”.

At this stage, no further action is required.

If any additional information is required by the OSAP processing team, you will be contacted via email.

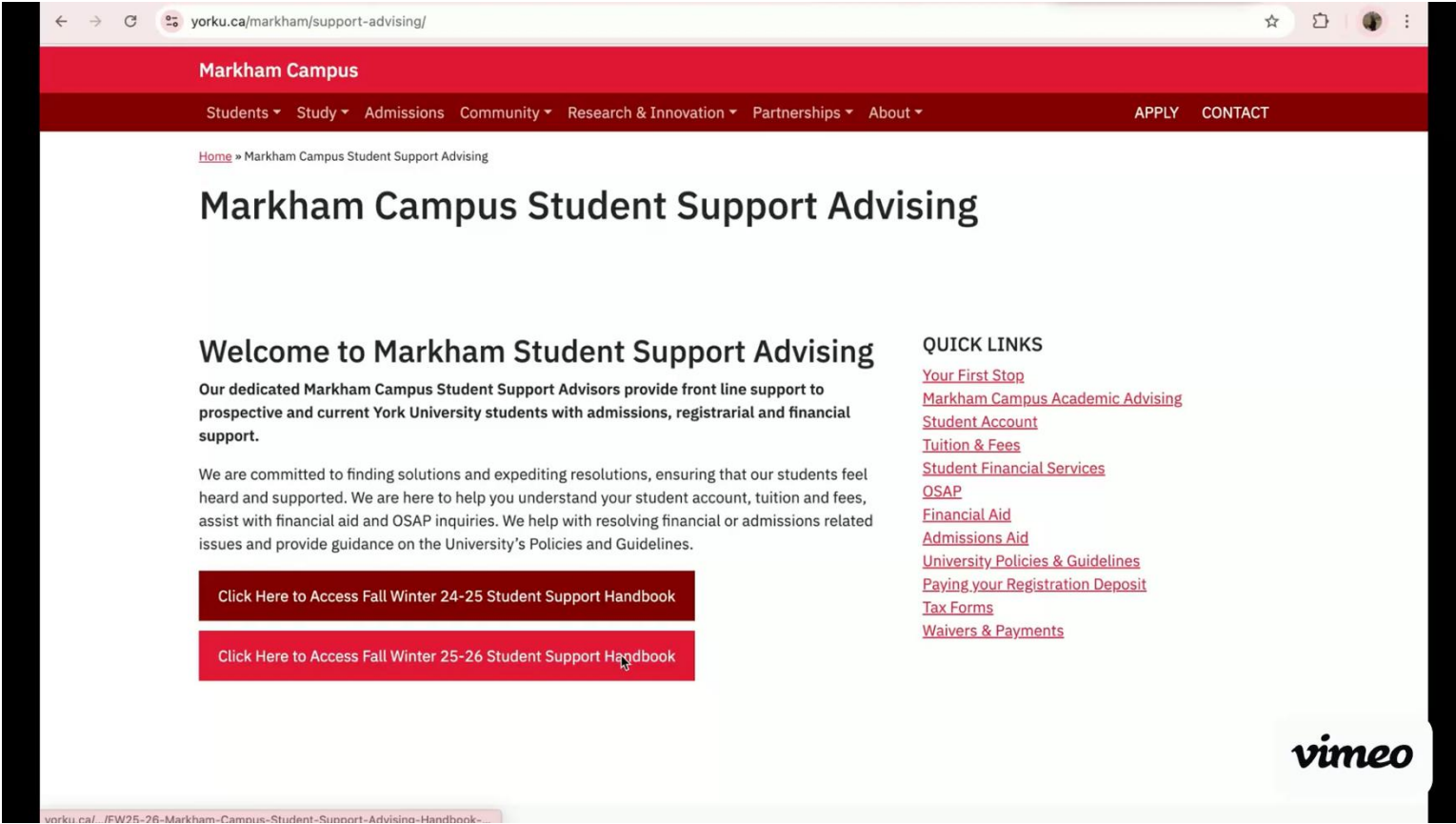
Part-time OSAP applications must be done through the OSAP website.
