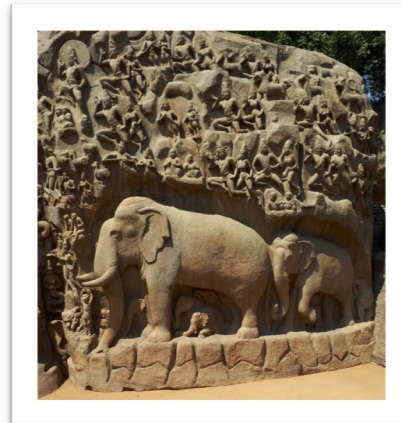

# Ontario India Student Exchange

## Full year/ One Term Exchange (OIN)

**Study in India and earn credits toward your degree in Canada**

### Timing

- 1 or 2 semesters

### Eligibility

- Undergraduate and graduate full-time degree students
- Should have completed at least 2 years of a recognized degree and have a high academic standing

### Language of Instruction

- English is the medium of instruction in all OIN partner institutions

### Costs

- Ontario tuition fees
- Students are responsible for expenses abroad, flight, health insurance, and other associated costs

### Credits

- Contact an academic advisor at your home institution for information on credit transfer

## Study India Program (SIP)

**Covers the study of India's art and architecture, history, culture, politics, social justice and gender issues. The experiential learning component includes visit to an NGO, the Taj Mahal and Delhi-area monuments.**

### Timing

- 4 weeks in August

### Eligibility

- Undergraduate and graduate degree students
- Registered in a degree program in the academic year of application

### Language of Instruction

- English

### Partner Institution

- Shiv Nadar University, Noida

### Costs

- Course fee is approx. CAD\$2,200 (based on 2020 fee)
- fee covers administration cost, airport pick-up, accommodation, most meals, tuition and trips
- Students pay for flight, some meals and costs associated with non-SIP-related travel

### Course Information

### Credits

- Contact the academic advisor at your home institution for information on credit transfer

## Short-term Study Program (SSP)

**Participate in a study project at an Indian institution (with a faculty member at the latter)**

### Timing

- Two to three months any time in the calendar year

### Eligibility

- Undergraduate and graduate students at one of the participating Ontario universities

### Language of Instruction

- English is the medium of instruction in all OIN partner institutions

### Placements

- Students need to find their own placement, e.g. with the help of their nominating Ontario professor

### Costs

- Students pay for living expenses in India, flight and other associated costs
- *There may be an academic fee payable to the host institution*
