

























WHY STUDY IN AUVERGNE-RHÔNE-ALPES ?

3 PROGRAMS

- Student Exchange Program (1 or 2 semesters)
- Summer Research Program (3 months)
- Summer Language Program (4 to 6 weeks)
- > Application deadline: confirm with your home university



ORA STUDENT EXCHANGE

- > 1 or 2 semesters
- > Area of study open
- Study in French. Some courses in English.
- Scholarship : \$2,500 for 1 semester, \$3,500 for 2 semesters
- Credits transferred toward your degree
- Students select 2 options for a host institution, 1st choice granted 90% of the time.



ORA STUDENT EXCHANGE

Courses in English :

- Most courses are taught in French, but all institutions offer some courses in English.
- Lists of courses taught in English soon available on the ORA website.
- > One main possibility of a full program in English at Université Jean Moulin Lyon 3 (SELF Program).



SUMMER RESEARCH PROGRAM

- > 2 or 3-month placement in a research group / lab at a university in AURA
- > Open to students in all disciplines
- Students identify their research group individually with the support of the ORA program office and the universities
- List of laboratories available on the ORA SRP webpage
- Participants are eligible for a stipend provided by the French research group or lab
- Scholarship : \$1,500.

SUMMER LANGUAGE PROGRAM

- > 4 to 6-week intensive program in French language and culture, with social and cultural activities
- Scholarship : \$1,200
- Credits transferred toward your degree (discretion of your home university)
- Students choose the language school and session from 4 options

- Introduction to the French academic system and culture



SCHOLARSHIPS

Student Exchange Program \$3,500 for two-semesters \$2,500 for one-semester Summer Research Program \$1,500 (plus a stipend from the French lab) Summer Language Program \$1,200

*Available to Canadian citizens or Permanent residents
